APPLYING FOR PROJECTS

eTRAKiT must be opened and used in **Internet Explorer**. Using any other browser can cause issues.

STEP 1 ENTER PROJECT INFORMATION

Applicants will have the option to apply for the following project types:

- **Property Information request**

The property information request includes Zoning Verification Letters, Non-residential Floodplain Information, and General Inquires.

- **Pre Application**

Pre application meetings are required prior to the submittal of the following project examples: Any new non-residential development; Expansion of existing non-residential building(s); Construction or expansion of any multi-family residential structure(s); Subdivisions; Exterior remodeling and/or site work on commercial or multi-family properties; Variances; or Special Use Permits. See the City's [Develop in Westminster](#) site for details on the development review process.

- **Formal Application Request**

When applying for any project choose Formal Application Request. This will produce a record request for our staff who will then be able to create a project. Projects include but are not limited to: Official Development Plans (ODP), ODP Amendments, Preliminary Development Plans (PDP), PDP Amendments, ODP Waiver, Special Use Permits, and Variances.

- **Master Plan**

This option is to be used for applying for and submitting master plans for residential projects.
