Responsibilities

- Work closely with all divisions and departments to review plans for proposed businesses and subdivisions located within the city.
- Administer local ordinances, policies and procedures.
- Review plans for public roadway, storm, water and sanitary sewer improvements and provide city construction inspections.
- Administer all Land Disturbance Permits and assure that any other permits from outside agencies that are required for the construction of projects have been obtained, monitor sureties and oversee project closeout.
- Administer responsible stormwater management.
- Provide floodplain management.
- Administer Right-of-Way permits for city streets.
- Provide project management for local, state and federally funded capital improvement projects. We oversee the design, right-of-way acquisition, construction, and inspection of projects including, but not limited to, new roadways, interchanges, bridges, water and sewer infrastructure and storm drainage improvements.
- Performs traffic engineering functions, including the placement of traffic control signs, the installation and maintenance of traffic signals, management of parking and transportation demand and the implementation of bicycle lanes and other multi-modal improvements.
- Provides transportation planning functions to identify and administer near-, mid-, and long-term multimodal transportation improvements, policies, plans, and guidance, in coordination with traffic engineering, other city departments, and external agencies.
- Develop and maintain the City's Geographical Information System database.
