Information Technology Internship

Internship Objective

The IT Internship will provide broad exposure to the entire department, including experience in four different areas: Network/Telecom, Software Engineering, Systems, and Operations.

Essential Job Functions, Duties, Responsibilities, and Tasks

1. Network/Telecom:
 - a. General discussions regarding network/telecom operations and how it applies with the City's infrastructure/design
 - b. Tour the data center and telecom closets to identify how communications are set up/established and maintained
 - c. Discuss the necessary education and requirements needed for a related career
 - d. Because access to the city's systems are extremely sensitive, hands-on access will be extremely limited, however the material would be of interest to students and deliver a good overall representation of a network/telecom staff's responsibilities

2. Software Engineering:
 - a. Shadow the following teams/individuals:
 - i. Application Development Team: perform a coding exercise or small program
 - ii. Database Administrator: see the cluster environment and study database schemas and queries, review relational database concepts, create queries to retrieve specific datasets
 - iii. Report Developer: see how to create Crystal Reports and SSRS reports, learn how to retrieve data for users
 - iv. Interface Developer (SSIS): see how to create ETL packages to extract, transform, and load data
 - v. Business Analyst: learn how to gather requirements from users and how to scope a project

3. Systems:
 - a. PC Imaging Process
 - b. PC Disposal Process, and how to "wipe" PC's
 - c. Customer service, Helpdesk duties, troubleshooting over the phone
 - d. Server maintenance and updates
 - e. Systems security
 - f. System backup and Recovery processes
 - g. Data Recovery Facility and Data Recovery capabilities

4. Operations:
 - a. Shadow operations team to gain insight in the organization and operations of the IT department including business analysis, project management, and budget

Preferred Qualifications

1. Interest in a career in Information Technology
2. Currently enrolled in a STEM program, computer programming or technology course, or similar
3. Some previous experience in computer technology
4. Good customer service and problem-solving skills
