- Old Business (15 Minutes)
  - o Review and Approve Previous Meeting Minutes
  - o Motion: Rich, 2<sup>nd</sup> Steve, passes unopposed
  - o Remaining Budget Decision:

Utility Assistance Fund <u>or</u> Vouchers to benefit People Experiencing Homelessness

- Supplementing the Utility Assistance Fund could prevent homelessness: 14 (or 10%) of the people experiencing homelessness (PEH) in Westminster on the night of the 2023 Point in Time annual census of PEH said utilities were a contributing factor to being homeless now.
- The Navigator budget quadrupled in 2023 from 2022 so the budget is healthy.
- o Council preferred that we pick between vouchers vs utility assistance fund
- o (Mayor Pro-Tem argued for keeping the money with the Board thanks!)
- o Motion Seth, 2<sup>nd</sup> Steve: recommend to Council that the remaining IBoard funds be transferred to the city's Utility Assistance Fund.
  - Miguel: can we use this as an opportunity to make a connection?
    - Water Resources Team, also Growing Home
  - Note: UAF is water-only; LEAP (Low-Income Energy Assistance Program) can help with electricity/gas
    - Means-based qualification; LEAP eligibility helps
  - Motion passes 7:1:1
- City Council Report (10 Minutes)
  - Mayor Pro Tem David DeMott
  - o Budget was passed; retention of city manager, attorney, judge all approved
  - o SWOT analysis of budget process to improve it next year
  - New council members incoming from yesterday's election; counts still ongoing
    - First new council meeting in December
  - o All the municipal ballot issues look to have passed, including creating wards
    - Wards will have to be drawn up, then approved by voters
  - o Proclamation honoring Michelle Haney
  - Ballot questions passed exploration of wards
    - How can IBoard be of service in development of a proposal for wards?
    - Mayor Pro Tem will take that question to Council
      - Committee composition, number of wards, etc.
      - First ad-hoc committee / task force in 2024?
