## • City Council Report (10 Minutes)

- o Councillor David DeMott
- New council sworn in, new mayor pro tem (Nurmela)
- Working toward strategic planning (setting objectives to give to staff), but teambuilding delayed by mayor's surgery
- o Rocky Mountain Municipal Airport noise roundtable
  - Venue for discussing noise complaints with FAA
  - Westy participation needed to keep other cities from being ignored
  - Concerns about lead; CDPHE coming to talk to city
    - Have talked to state reps about it
    - But technically topic is outside noise roundtable's purview
- o Uplands development continues in motion
- o Preliminary Development Plan process
- o Council assignments revisited; DeMott still w/ IBoard
- o Coming cold snap: staff is working on making warming facilities available
- o Busy (holidays, new council), but no big changes

#### • New Business

- Open forum
- o Resident expressed interest in new citizen events; may be restarting post-COVID
  - Would make a lot of sense for IBoard to be involved
  - Was run through Libraries (Lou Wright), but no longer have resources / volunteers
  - Topic for conversation with PROSLAB; could need a cross-board effort
- o Visiting boards invite new city councilors to attend next meeting
- o Senior services recent crisis with Meals on Wheels in Adams County
  - Steve inquired w/ someone there about needs
  - Senior Hub
  - Human services generally provided at county level
- Transportation for seniors (Alan)
  - Coral Gables has jitney service for shopping, doctors, etc.
  - Funding from ads, merchants
  - Current city demographics
  - Westminster Boulevard senior living community in development by Frickson
  - Service from Via has ended due to funding inefficiency; council open to new / alternate options

- Bring it up with city manager? Can we get numbers?
- Ambassadors
  - Outreach / canvassing to collect info about needs
  - Leverage community nights put on by PROSLAB? (if they are happening in 2024) – need to find out more
  - Meeting of chairs of advisory boards to look for synergy / collaboration
  - Difficulty of defining neighborhoods present challenges to communication
    & outreach
  - City outreach to community is decentralized
    - Jake is on comms team
  - Lots of folks feel unheard, but hard to say how to fix that
  - Wards & Districts have to figure out what they should look like
    - Need to get many voices at the table to make best proposal possible
  - Many folks lack strong community ties (based on location)
    - Lack of third places
  - Supporting community events (block parties, etc.)
    - Partner with PROSLAB (existing program)
  - Recent PRL survey probably through consultancy
  - (Community-building is hard and complicated)
