

## **IROW Pre Submittal Process:**

Before a Fiber Contractor can apply for an IROW permit via eTRAKiT they need to register with the city as a Public Way Contractor and provide the COI information.

- PRIOR to submitting for a permit the Fiber Contractor needs to coordinate with the Project Manager and IROW team and submit plans of their "Designated Area," or proposed project area, via email.
  - Each permit submitted will be linked to one Designated Area.
  - o The proposed Designated Area can be emailed to the PM and IROW team.
- The fiber contractor and the GIS Coordinator are notified once the PM has approved the Designated Area.
  - The Fiber Contractor will provide the Designated Area to the GIS Coordinator via email (KMZ file).
  - o The GIS Coordinator will add the Designated Area to GIS and TRAKIT.
- After the Designated Area is added to GIS and TRAKIT the Fiber Contractor can apply for the IROW permit via eTRAKIT.
  - o The only permit type they should be applying for is an IROW.
  - o Each IROW permit submitted is to be linked to one Designated Area.

Once the permit is submitted the permit review process will begin.
