NEPA SUMMARY

During October 2017, the City of Westminster, Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT), and Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) staff discussed the city's *Downtown Westminster Smart City Mobility Initiative* TIGER application via phone and e-mail. A written summary of the project description, an aerial photograph showing the proposed improvements, and a cost estimate were sent to CDOT and FHWA staff. Westminster staff confirmed that all project components lie within CDOT operating right-of-way.
