Westminster's TIGER application proposes to construct a grade separation of the 18 mile long US 36 Bikeway which was constructed as part of the nationally recognized US 36 Express Lanes Project. The bikeway carried more than 175,000 riders in its first year. The underpass will do much more than facilitate cycling. It will improve safety by eliminating the need for bicyclists and pedestrians to cross fourteen lanes of traffic across Sheridan Boulevard and 88th Avenue to access one of the Denver Regional Transportation District's busiest park n rides.
