Yellowstone to the Grand Canyon

9 Days June 6-14, 2022

Day 1 – After your flight to Salt Lake City, your deluxe motorcoach will meet you at the airport and stay with you for the next nine days.

Today take a guided tour of Temple Square beginning at the North Visitors' Center and includes why it took 40 years to build the Salt Lake Temple; the wonder of the Tabernacle, home of the Mormon Tabernacle Choir; the Faith and Fortitude of the Mormon Pioneers; and the 11 foot marble Christus statue.

Then check into a downtown Salt Lake City hotel for the night. Dinner this evening is included at The Roof Restaurant, Utah's premier gourmet dining buffet located on the 10th floor of the Joseph Smith Memorial Building. With breathtaking views of Temple Square and Downtown Salt Lake City, The Roof is a fusion of inspiring views and delicious food. The menu includes a renowned dessert buffet and exciting international cuisine along with traditional favorites. **(D)**

Day 2 – Travel today takes you to Yellowstone National Park where this afternoon you meet your local guide and tour the world's first national park. Yellowstone is a wonderland of natural beauty and geologic oddities. Visit the centerpiece of the park, Old Faithful. There will be plenty of time to explore the area, witness an eruption of the world's most famous geyser.

Check into your West Yellowstone, Montana hotel for a two night stay. Dinner is included this evening at the Three Bear Restaurant. **(B,D)**

Day 3 – This morning visit the Grizzly Discovery Center to watch bears and wolves in their natural environments. The Center offers every visitor to Yellowstone a chance to uniquely experience the world of grizzly bears and gray wolves. All the animals at the Grizzly & Wolf Discover Center are unable to survive in the wild and serve as ambassadors for their wild counterparts. Before departing you will view an IMAX movie about the history of Yellowstone.

Today, enjoy the Upper Loop Tour of Yellowstone which takes you to the northern reaches of the park. From West Yellowstone you get to see the Majestic Grand Canyon of the Yellowstone. You then head North east through Dunraven Pass which is a great area to spot both Grizzly and Black Bears. Then on to Tower Falls and out into the Lamar Valley where more bears as well as Bison, and Wolves are often spotted. You travel to Mammoth Hot Springs for a walk through the colorful terraced formations and visit Dunraven Pass as well as the beautiful Lamar Valley keeping an eye out for Deer, Pronghorn and Big Horn Sheep along the route.

Enjoy a picnic dinner as the sun begins its slow descent, the best time of the day to view wildlife. Keep the cameras ready for elk, bison, moose, wolves and bear frequently make an appearance in these areas at dusk. It will be a late return to your hotel after an unforgettable experience in Yellowstone. **(B,D)**

Day 4 - After breakfast and check out, return to Yellowstone National Park this morning. See where the mighty Yellowstone River has cut its way through sheer rock to cascade down hundreds of feet to the foaming torrents below. Next, drive through scenic Hayden Valley, famous for large herds of buffalo and other wildlife. A box lunch is included today during your park visit. By late afternoon you exit Yellowstone through the South Gate and enter Grand Teton National Park.

This afternoon visit Grand Teton National Park. Rising above a scene rich with extraordinary wildlife, pristine lakes, and alpine terrain, the Teton Range stands monument to the people who fought to protect it. These are mountains of the imagination. Then check into your Jackson Hole, Wyoming for the night. Your evening is free to spend time on your own and discover the Old West. **(B,L)**

Day 5 – Following breakfast, enjoy a Snake River Float Trip. With the magnificent snowcapped Teton Range as your backdrop, your professional guide will treat you to an experience that you will remember for a lifetime.

Travel continues this afternoon to Provo, Utah your home for the night. Enjoy an included dinner this evening at a local restaurant. **(B,D)**

Day 6 – Today, travel takes you to Bryce Canyon, famous for its worldly unique geology, consists of a series of horseshoe-shaped amphitheaters carved from the eastern edge of the Paunsaugunt Plateau. The erosional force of frost-wedging and the dissolving power of rainwater have shaped the colorful limestone rock of the Claron Formation into bizarre shapes, including slot canyons, windows, fins, and spires called "hoodoos".

Check into your Bryce, Utah hotel for the night. Tonight, enjoy a dinner show at Ebenezer's Barn and Grill. Enjoy a western style buffet while being entertained by a live country music show. Playing nightly at Ebenezer's are the Bryce Canyon Wranglers. They are a group of musicians assembled from Nashville, Tennessee bringing their own rendition of country western hits, both traditional and new, as well as some of their own original material. **(B,D)**

Day 7 – Today, visit Zion National Park. Gaze up at massive sandstone cliffs of cream, pink, and red that soar into a brilliant blue sky. Challenge your courage in a narrow slot canyon. Zion's unique array of plants and animals will enchant you as you absorb the rich history of the past and enjoy the excitement of present day adventures. A box lunch will be provided for you today.

Travel this afternoon takes you to Arizona and the Cameron Trading Post, where past and present meet. Native American arts and crafts, jewelry and fine antique collectibles housed in an authentic turn-of-the-century trading post. Your overnight stay will be at the Trading Post Motel and dinner is included this evening. **(B,L,D)**

Day 8 – This morning experience larger-than-life reality as you arrive at the Grand Canyon for a Freedom Rim Tour. For moments you'll remember for the rest of your life, you will meet a local guide for a tour that will immerse you in the miracle of the Grand Canyon. Visit some of the South Rim's most spectacular overlooks. This is a great way to spend the afternoon. After your tour, you will have free time for lunch on your own and time to visit the area.

Continue travel this afternoon to Las Vegas, NV for a night on the Strip. Enjoy a free evening where you are just a few steps away from dining, entertainment and the casinos. Dinner is on your own. **(B)**

Day 9 - A breakfast buffet is included this morning at the casino. Then you will meet your motorcoach for transportation to the Las Vegas airport to meet your return flight home. **(B)**
