## **IS THE EVENT FREE?**

## HOW DO I GET TO THE EVENT?

**SHUTTLES-** We highly recommend utilizing our shuttle system to get to and from the event. These will run about every 20 minutes starting at 6 p.m. Front Range Community College and The MAC have wheelchair accessible buses. Service animals only (no pets). Courtesy golf carts will be available at the event for those with mobility needs.

Getting Home on Shuttles: Shuttles will pick up at City Park Recreation Center and drop off at the designated shuttle stops. Shuttles run from the conclusion of the fireworks show until the park is cleared out.

**Parking-** If parking at the event, please use 105<sup>th</sup> from Sheridan, or the Christopher Fields entrance from 104<sup>th</sup>. **Handicap Parking-** Is located near the fitness center. Let parking attendants or traffic officers know if you require a closer spot. These spaces are limited.

**Biking-** There will be a free bike valet located on the north section of the park near the parking lot. **Uber/Lyft-** May drop off and pick up on Sheridan <u>southbound</u> only, between 107<sup>th</sup> Drive and 105<sup>th</sup> Avenue. There will be signage.

#### PETS

#### **PROHIBITED ITEMS**

Outside alcohol (*visit one of our beer vendors instead*), laser pointers, glass containers, no weapons of any type, gas or charcoal grills, no marijuana use allowed in the event (*public marijuana use is illegal*). All bags, containers, and packages are subject to search.

### **ZERO WASTE**

We are proud to be working with Scraps to produce very little waste during this event. Please look at the sorting stations and sort trash accordingly. Everything you purchase from food vendors should go into the compost bin.

### **SAFETY INFORMATION**
