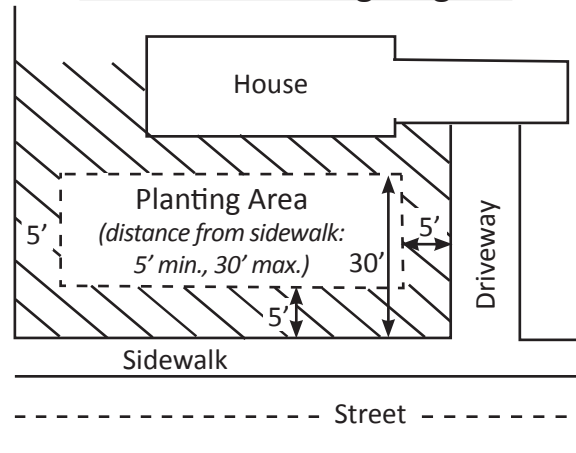


Think Trees! for Westminster's Future

ReLeaf Westy Tree Rebate Program

The City of Westminster Department of Parks, Recreation and Libraries is offering cash rebates for participants in its Tree Rebate Program. This program is designed to encourage citizens to plant trees to improve their own property, as well as to enhance the look and image of the City of Westminster as a growing community. Planting trees near the street helps shade and cool the environment. Let's grow together and "THINK TREES" for Westminster's future.



Requirements

The Tree Rebate Program provides a \$60 rebate for a tree planted by a Westminster residential property owner and meeting the following requirements:

1. All trees are to be planted within the Westminster City limits.
2. The tree must have a minimum purchase price of \$80.
3. The tree must be one of those listed in this pamphlet, or be approved by the City Forester.
4. The tree must be planted in the front yard of the property (see diagram, other side).
5. Completed application forms along with a copy of your receipt showing your tree purchase must be submitted to the Department of Parks, Recreation, and Libraries by October 31. Applications received after this date will not be honored.
6. Rebates are subject to verification of fulfilling requirements.
7. Funding is limited and rebates will be given on a first come / first served basis.
8. Trees purchased through the Westy Tree purchase program and planted in the front yard, are eligible for a \$25 rebate.
