

## **SLBT Update for the Week of August 5, 2019**

Additional cable/swage prototypes have been produced by board members for vetting purposes.

- \* A “T-Bar” prototype has been produced for vetting purposes that could be utilized through a drain plug hole in lieu of having permit holders drill holes into the hull of their boats.
- \* Nokē has sent pictures of the integrated cable/lock system that they have been asked to manufacture for us. They will be sending the prototype to staff for further vetting next week.
- \* Nokē locks were received and distributed to the internal taskforce for further testing. Water Quality personnel and IT staff are currently testing the lock and will have their findings by the scheduled August 19<sup>th</sup> meeting. This internal taskforce is comprised of at least two staff from each department (IT, Risk Management, City Manager’s Office, Public Works and Utilities, City Attorney’s Office, Parks, Rec & Libraries) and tasked with vetting the new security protocols.
- \* SL has purchased an additional spray station that will help in reducing the wait time on decontamination sprays for non-motorized boats.
- \* The Next SLBT Sub-Committee meeting is tentatively scheduled for August 22.
