

SLBT Update for the Week of July 8, 2019

- Holly Walters, Standley Lake Coordinator, met with the “Tagging Sub-Committee” prior to the SLBT meeting on June 27th. The meeting focused on the progress that has been made with the Nokē lock and some recommended adjustments on the cable and swage component of the program. It was decided to not have the swage covered with an identifiable cover and instead have a serialized, random 7 digit code etched or stamped onto the swage directly. Committee members are looking for machine shops that can accommodate this request while agreeing to the terms of Westminster in not duplicating this process for any individuals.
- During the SLBT meeting on June 27th, Holly Walters presented on the ANS Security Program in its entirety (Nokē, Cable/Swage, Secure -XP Tag, WID mobile application, increased penalties, etc.). The SLBT agreed to move the proposed solution forward for vetting by City Attorney’s Office (CAO), Risk Management (RM), City manager’s Office (CMO), Parks, Recreation, and Libraries (PRL), Public Works and Utilities (PWU), and Information Technology (IT).
