

Westminster Med

A Membership Program for Ambulance Service

Provided by the City of Westminster





What is Westminster Med?

Westminster Med is an annual membership program that helps cover the cost of emergency paramedic ambulance service.

How much does it cost?

Annual membership is only \$55 per family or \$35 per individual.

Who is covered under Westminster Med?

Your Westminster Med membership covers you, your spouse, unmarried children under 25, and all other persons listed as dependents on your tax return regularly living at your residence.

Who is eligible to be a member?

Membership is available to all residents within the Westminster Fire Department ambulance service area. Benefits of this program may be extended to certain areas outside of the city's ambulance service area that have similar programs.

Why should I join?

Emergency ambulance service is expensive to provide. The metro area median cost to a patient for ambulance transportation is over \$700. Westminster Med is the perfect alternative to having to pay for this costly service. A Westminster Med member requiring ambulance service even once can save hundreds of dollars.

How does Westminster Med work with my health insurance?

Complete coverage of ambulance transportation may not be provided by your medical insurance. Full paramedic ambulance costs are seldom paid in full. Medicare, for example, covers approximately 80 percent of the bill, you would still owe the balance. Most medical plans have annual deductibles and coinsurance that you must pay.

Is this program right for me?

Please check with your insurance provider to see if Westminster Med would be beneficial to you and your family. (Participants in welfare health programs, most commonly known as Medicaid, will not benefit from this program because of the Medicaid reimbursement structure and should not join the program).

How does the program work?

If you require emergency ambulance service as a Westminster Med member, the city will bill your insurance.

The city will accept the insurance payment as payment in full. Any uninsured portion of the ambulance bill that you would normally be required to pay will not be collected by the city.

Your annual fee entitles you and listed members to emergency ambulance service as often as needed during the year. Non-emergency ambulance transportation for routine, scheduled, or other non-emergency medical care is not covered. Please read the Westminster Med agreement for a full explanation and terms of coverage.
